Spring Means Sprucing Up

Are you ready for a Carolina coastal spring? Here are a few quick steps to make sure your cooling system is prepared for the first big heat wave.

☐ Replace air filters (ideally every 1-3 months)
☐ Test cooling mode on your thermostat
☐ Clear leaves/debris from outdoor unit
☐ Flush the condensate drain line
☐ Dust or vacuum around indoor vents and returns
☐ Schedule a spring tune-up to clean coils, check refrigerant, inspect fan motor
☐ Bonus: check windows and doors for air leaks
Fall is for Filters
Even though winters in Wilmington are mild, you'll still want a system that's ready when the temps drop and you want to be cozy.
☐ Replace air filters
☐ Switch the thermostat to heat to make sure it responds
☐ Clear outdoor unit of leaves, pine needles, or other debris
☐ Check thermostat schedule
☐ Dust or vacuum around indoor vents and returns
☐ Schedule a fall tune-up to inspect burners and check for CO leaks if gas-powered
☐ Bonus: check windows and doors for air leaks and install stopgaps
